



Sunbury/ Big Walnut Chamber of Commerce 2010 Farmer's Market

RULES AND REGULATIONS

All vendors must register with the Sunbury/Big Walnut Area Chamber of Commerce. There are three options for vendor passes.

- * Option A: Week-by-Week @ \$10 per week
- * Option B: Season @ \$100 for 22 weeks
- * Option C: available ONLY to produce growers - 8 week "Growers Pass" for \$60.
This punch pass is good for 8 Saturday's throughout the season and must be presented each week.

Farmers are to sell what they produce (**no dock or warehouse produce**). We allow **homemade** baked goods, cheeses, jams, salsa, honey, soap, lotion, etc., provided that the processed foods have met all of the State and Local Regulations. As a precaution to food allergies, please label all foods that may contain allergens. Vendors set their own prices.

All items to be sold must be "homegrown" or "homemade". The only exception will be for sponsors' booth space on designated sponsor days during the 2010 Farmers' Market. Sponsors will be asked to set up in a specific location on the designated Saturday(s) and must provide their own table.

The Sunbury/Big Walnut Chamber of Commerce will assign vendors a place on a "**First Come, First Serve**" basis. These locations are usually the width of a parking spot. Tables and tents are **not** provided. Electricity and refrigeration are **not** available at the market.

Setup begins at 8:00 a.m. on Saturdays. The market will run from 9:00 a.m. to 12:00 p.m. commencing **May 22, 2010 through October 16, 2010** and will operate **RAIN OR SHINE**. Vendors are to provide their own rain gear.

Vendor displays must not impede pedestrian traffic on the sidewalk, nor impede vehicular traffic or pedestrian traffic on the street. Displays may not be placed on exterior walls or windows of the downtown businesses.

There will be **no smoking** in the farmers' market vendor's area. Vendors are asked to smoke outside of the Farmers' Market area.

No loud radios or shouting of prices.

Vendors are responsible for cleaning their areas; removing all produce, containers, signs and trash/messes at the end of the day or when they leave.

Grievances or problems are to be directed to the Sunbury/Big Walnut Chamber of Commerce for resolution.

It shall be the Vendor's responsibility to obtain all licensing and permits, and to pay any and all fees associated with those licenses and permits by Local and State governing bodies. This includes, but is not limited to, the Vendor's License for goods sold for which a sales tax must be collected.

Vendors must comply with all laws, ordinances, and regulations of the United States, State of Ohio and Sunbury, Ohio (which uses the Delaware County Health Department Regulations and inspectors).

Items that will **NOT BE PERMITTED** are the following: (1) Sale of live animals (2) Flea market items (3) Foods that are prepared on the premises (i.e. concession stand types of food).
