Sunbury Big Walnut Chamber of Commerce Endorses Delaware County Transit Ballot Initiative

SUNBURY, OHIO — The Sunbury Big Walnut Chamber of Commerce announces its endorsement of the November 3 ballot initiative to provide sustainable local funding for the expansion of Delaware County Transit services.

As Delaware County continues to experience significant residential and economic growth, access to reliable transportation is increasingly important to our businesses, workforce, seniors, families, and community organizations.

The proposed **0.20% sales tax** would provide Delaware County Transit with a dedicated local funding source to expand transportation options throughout the county. The proposed improvements include:

- Expansion of FLEX on-demand rideshare service into Powell and Orange Township, as well as portions of Liberty and Genoa townships.
- Expanded hours and seven-day-a-week service in the City of Delaware.
- Same-day, countywide demand-response service providing scheduled curb-to-curb transportation.
- Commuter express service to and from downtown Columbus.

The initiative would expand access to Delaware County Transit's on-demand services to approximately **100,000 additional Delaware County residents**, with the proposed service improvements expected to be fully implemented over approximately five years.

For the Sunbury Big Walnut Chamber of Commerce, transportation is also an economic development and workforce issue. Reliable transportation helps connect employees with employers, customers with businesses, seniors with essential services, and residents with opportunities throughout our growing county.

Expanded transit can also help address traffic congestion, provide greater independence for older adults, create transportation alternatives for teenagers and families, and strengthen connections between Delaware County communities.

The Chamber recognizes that any proposed tax deserves careful consideration. After reviewing the transportation needs of our rapidly growing county and the potential benefits to residents and businesses, we believe investment in a sustainable transportation network is important to Delaware County's continued economic vitality and quality of life.

The **Sunbury Big Walnut Chamber of Commerce** supports the **Delaware County Transit initiative on the November 3 ballot** and encourages residents to learn more about the proposal and its potential impact on the future of transportation in Delaware County.
